

RECIPE FOR MAKING AN SCCA CORNER WORKER

1. Go to www.houscca.com and enter "Race Workers", read all about corner working
2. Fill out an SCCA application form and pay for your membership.
3. Travel to Texas World Speedway, Hwy 6 (outside College Station, TX).
4. Arrive at the Registration Building at 7am on Sat/Sun to register. Go to head of line, mentioning that you are there to work flagging and communications. You will have to have a photo taken which will be laminated to your membership card. If you choose, you can pay your membership in cash at that time and you will get a temporary card until your permanent one comes in the mail. You will also sign a waiver.
5. Your membership card will have a entrance sticker placed on it. This is your pass.
6. Enter the track at the main gate, displaying your pass to security guard.
7. Go directly to trackside, through the track gate and meet the Flag Chief.
8. The Flag Chief will assign you to a corner with a corner captain.
9. The corner worker meeting is usually held at 7:30am sharp. Do not miss it.
10. Find your corner captain and let him know that you are new to F&C.
11. Ask the Flag Chief for an F&C Log card. This is a record of all the races that you work
12. The Flag Chief will sign the log card at the end of the race weekend.
13. When you renew your membership, make a copy of this card and send it to SCCA License Renewal Dept. and ask for the F&C Specialty rating.. Do not send this card with your membership renewal, as they go to two different places. Mail separately.
14. Now go out and **PLAY SAFE!** You will receive F&C training on the job. There are also F&C schools held during the year for more training as well as Fire Safety Schools.
15. Race schedules are on the Houston Region SCCA website. Work as many as you can for developing your F&C skills. License upgrades are based on interest and performance, not just for attendance.
